

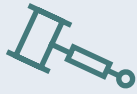

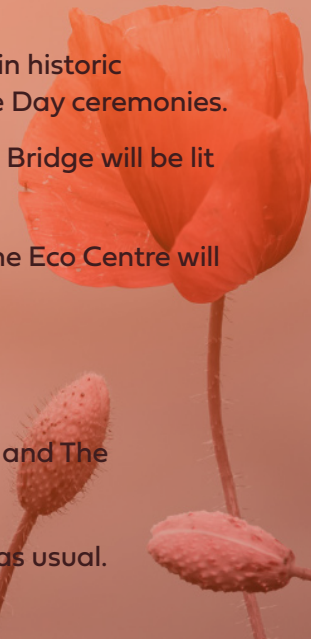
Remembrance Day 2023

- From 9 a.m. - 12 p.m., streets surrounding Cenotaph Park in historic downtown will be closed to accommodate Remembrance Day ceremonies.
- Flags will be at half mast and the Jack Tennant Memorial Bridge will be lit up in honour of Remembrance Day.
- Cochrane facilities, including The Station and the Cochrane Eco Centre will be closed.

Monday, Nov 13

- All Cochrane facilities, including the Cochrane Eco Centre and The Station will be closed.
- Waste, recycling and organics collection will be collected as usual.
