WATER/WASTEWATER OPERATOR I

The responsibilities include:

- Operation and control of the water treatment plant through the use of SCADA control, including troubleshooting, maintenance and treatment processes.
- Analysis of raw and treated water for treatment through chemical and physical processes.
- Inspection and maintenance of water plant pumping and chemical feed systems, lift and booster station pumps and equipment.
- Safe handling of water treatment chemicals.
- Maintain and interpret operating records and monthly reports.
- Install, repair and read water meters and remote readers.
- Rotate through after hours on-call shifts and provide 24-hour emergency response.
- Assist in the isolation and repair of distribution and collection system appurtenances.

Required skills and qualifications:

- Minimum Grade XII or equivalent
- AEP Certificates (or related municipal experience), preferred.
- Applicants with a Level I Certification *or a similar combination of experience and mechanical aptitude will also be considered.*
- Valid Class 3 Alberta Operator's License with Q endorsement is preferred.
