Welcoming Spring in Cochrane!

As the the colours of spring start to appear, it's time to revitalize our homes and neighborhoods with a thorough spring clean-up! Cochrane is dedicated to supporting our residents in their quest for a fresh start, both indoors and outdoors.

Turning on your outdoor taps?

Residential water use in Cochrane rises as much as 30% in the spring and summer months!

With anticipated drought conditions, consider ways that you can reduce your water use outdoors and save money before turning

on your taps this spring! You efforts can help Cochrane and other communities that rely on the Bow River and its connections.

Capture water with a rain barrel

Collecting and reusing rainwater can reduce your utility bill. You can receive a 50% rebate on the purchase of a rain barrel, to a maximum of \$50 per barrel at cochrane.ca/rebates.

Naturescaping

Conserve water through creative landscaping. Once established, a carefully and thoughtfully naturescaped area will be virtually maintenance free.

On Saturday, May 4 and 11, bring your bucket and shovel to collect free compost!

Residents are invited to Cochrane's lagoon site, near SLS Centre, at 141 Bow Bend Way to collect up to two pails. Get your garden growing and prepare your soil for warmer weather.

Weed control program starting soon

Following the Weed Control Act to control certain plant species, parks staff control weeds in our community using an integrated system to ensure all reasonable steps are taken to protect and enhance our natural, recreational and non-recreational environments.

As early as May 24 parks crews may begin treating targeted areas with herbicides, steam treatment and other forms of weed control, weather permitting. Watch for the yellow signs that are placed at the time of application, including product safety data sheet information.
