- i. ERTF progress to date

Mike Korman shared the Economic Recovery Task Force (ERTF) progress to date. The ERTF has sent out a survey with 160 responses, created an Open & Safe Campaign, created 5 Open & Safe videos with more coming. The ERTF has submitted 4 council recommendations. There will be a big campaign launching in 2021 called Think Big, Live Cochrane.

- ii. SRTF progress to date

Kim Krawec shared the Social Recovery Task Force (SRTF) progress to date. The SRTF sent out two surveys, one to engage the public one for organizations. SRTF is preparing a speaker series to address the top themes that came out of the public engagement survey including a Back to School Panel, Building Community lecture, Moving from Surviving to Thriving panel discussion, Conflict Resolution session and a talk from Jodi Carrington.

FCSS staff have done a variety of mental health pop ups, holding financial sessions, business continuity planning and promoting block parties. On the FCSS website there is a page for non-profit resources and grant opportunities.

The SRTF applied for a grant to increase the awareness of the CARES app, provide cell phones to Big Hill Haven clients and upgrade the technology in the FCSS basement meeting rooms
