DRAFT LAND USE BYLAW PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing for Land Use Bylaw 01/2022 provided the opportunity for residents and stakeholders to comment and ask questions. Council received and considered all comments submitted and presented during the public hearing.

BORROWING BYLAW – PHASE 2 CENTRE AVENUE AND HIGHWAY 1A IMPROVEMENTS

Town Administration presented Council with a borrowing bylaw to support phase 2 of the Centre Avenue and Highway 1A improvements project. The approved 2022 budget included the \$10.3M capital project, which includes completion of the widening of Centre Avenue to four lanes from William to Powell, and the completion of Highway 1A from west of Centre Avenue to west of 5th Avenue, including the connections to downtown, and construction along 4th Avenue, including the retaining wall.

The total project cost is funded through the Canada Community-Building Fund Grant (\$2,060,000) and \$8,240,000 in Off-Site Levy supported debt funding. Council gave first reading to the borrowing bylaw which will now be followed by the required advertising before coming back to Council for consideration of adoption.
