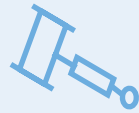

Notice is hereby given that the Development Authority has authorized the issuance of the following Development Permit(s) in accordance with the Town of Cochrane Land Use Bylaw #01/2004:

Permit No: DP2021-190

Legal Address: Lot 6, Block 26, Plan 161 0575

Municipal Address: 297 Riviera Way

Type: Excavation and Stockpiling (Stripping and Grading)

Use: Discretionary

Any person who deems to be affected by the issuance of these permits may appeal to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board by 4:30 p.m., April 28, 2022. On Permitted Uses, grounds for appeal must relate to questions of interpretation, variance, or relaxation, and not to the proposed use. On Discretionary Uses, all aspects of the proposed development may be challenged upon appeal. Written notice of appeal, accompanied by the appeal fee as established by Town Council, shall be filed through the Office of the Secretary of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board at 101 RancheHouse Road Cochrane, Alberta T4C 2K8.
