The Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB) of the Town of Cochrane will hear the appeal filed by the appellant against the decision of the Development Authority regarding the following development permit:

Application No: DP2022-067
Legal Description: Lot 6 Block 26 Plan 161 0575

Proposed Development: Dwelling, Semi-Detached and Single Detached (33 Units)
SDAB Hearing No.: 22-009

The SDAB hearing will commence at 6:30 pm on Wednesday, November 30, 2022 in Council Chambers, Cochrane RanchoHouse, 101 RanchoHouse Road, Cochrane AB. The hearing will be open to the public, and the SDAB will accept written and/or verbal presentations from affected persons, as listed in Section 687 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26. Written reports must be submitted to the Clerk digitally 5 days prior to the hearing.

Sanitary System Inspections

Proactive maintenance of Cochrane's utilities and infrastructure is crucial to extend the life of vital assets. In coming weeks, overnight sanitary sewer inspections and cleaning will take place in Glenbow, East End, Riverview, The Quarry and Downtown, this work will take an evening or two for each area. This work must take place overnight when the waste volume in the pipes is low and traffic is at a minimum to minimize community impact.

HWY 1A Improvements Project: Update

With the construction season coming to a close, you may be wondering what the highway will look like as we wrap up work for the year.

- 4 lanes of traffic on Hwy 1A will be opened east of 4th Ave to the Big Hill
- 2 lanes of traffic on Hwy 1A will be open west of 4th Ave
- Both Hwy 1A intersections at 4th Ave and 5th Ave will be open over the winter
- The speed limit through town will revert to 50 km/h from 30 km/h
- The speed limit heading down the big hill will remain unchanged at 60km/h

Work on the 4th Ave wall will continue through the winter and the new pedestrian pathways will be open and cleared of snow.

The progress that has been made to this point has enhanced traffic flow through Cochrane and will continue to increase community connectivity.

This major project has had an impact on everyone in the community and we want to say thank you for your patience, Cochrane.
