## NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Development Authority has authorized the issuance of the following Time Extension in accordance with the Town of Cochrane Land Use Bylaw #01/2004:

Permit No: DP2021-133

Legal Address: Lot W6, Block 1, Plan 781 1169

Municipal Address: 88 Glenpatrick Crescent

Type: Time Extension–Addition to Single Detached Dwelling & Variance to the Deck Side Yard Setback (Existing)

Use: Permitted with Variance

Any person who deems to be affected by the issuance of this permit may appeal to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board by 4:30 p.m., December 22, 2022. On Permitted Uses, grounds for appeal must relate to questions of interpretation, variance, or relaxation, and not to the proposed use. On Discretionary Uses, all aspects of the proposed development may be challenged upon appeal. Written notice of appeal, accompanied by the appeal fee as established by Town Council, shall be filed through the Office of the Secretary of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board at 101 RancheHouse Road Cochrane, Alberta T4C 2K8.

## Stay Off Storm Water Ponds



There are no circumstances in which the ice on storm water ponds is safe to walk, skate or play on. The surface may look solid, but changes underneath present significant danger.

Runoff typically contains concentrations of salt and/or warmed water, which can thin ice surfaces rapidly and may not be evident from the surface. There also may be a sudden change to the water level under the ice, resulting in unstable and unsafe conditions.
