Written notice of appeal, accompanied by the appeal fee as established by Town Council, shall be filed through the Office of the Secretary of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board at 101 RancheHouse Road Cochrane, Alberta T4C 2K8.

Stay Off Storm Water Facilities



There are no circumstances in which the ice on storm water facilities is safe to walk, skate or play on. The surface may look solid, but changes underneath present significant danger.

Runoff typically contains concentrations of salt and/or warmed water, which can thin ice surfaces rapidly and may not be evident from the surface. There also may be a sudden change to the water level under the ice, resulting in unstable and unsafe conditions.
