

2020 Water Conservation Rebate Program

High Efficiency Toilet Rebate

Replacing your old toilet with a new High Efficiency model will reduce household water consumption and put money back into your pocket!

As part of the 2020 Water Conservation Rebate Program, the Town of Cochrane is offering residents a \$50 rebate on the purchase price of a new WaterSense approved 4.8 Litre/flush toilet.

To be eligible for a rebate, your new toilet(s) must meet WaterSense standards; check out [WaterSense](#) for more information on approved toilets.

Maximum three toilet rebates per household.

Models that use less water per flush rating are eligible for a rebate.

Dual flush toilets with a 3.0L/4.8L flush rating are eligible for a rebate.

Dual flush toilets with a 4.0L/6.0L flush rating are no longer eligible for a rebate.

Dual flush conversion and retrofit kits are not eligible for the rebate.

New basement developments and houses built after 2006 do not qualify for a rebate.

Applications must be submitted within one year of the purchase date.

Your home must be on the Town's residential water metered system, or the toilet(s) must be installed in a commercial, institutional or apartment building on the metered system.
