



## **George Fox Trail, Griffin Road and James Walker Trail Construction – Summer 2019**

September 3, 2019

**Milling of the asphalt road surface on George Fox Trail will begin on Tuesday, September 3 and will continue throughout the week. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic as construction crews work on alternating sides of the roadway.**

**\*\*Please be aware that this may result in delays, particularly with first day of school traffic in the area.\*\***

**Traffic may also be restricted at various times at the intersection of Cowboy Trail (Highway 22) and George Fox Trail. Paving operations are expected to be mostly complete by September 13, subject to weather conditions. Construction operations on George Fox Trail should be complete by the end of September 2019.**

**Griffin Road paving is complete. The crosswalks and bike lane symbols will be added in mid-September.**

**James Walker Trail construction is progressing and is on track for completion by the end of next construction season.**

Regular maintenance and upgrading are an important part of improving safety and extending the life of our roadways. The Town of Cochrane will be doing roadway surface, pathway, and ditch improvements to George Fox Trail, as well as roadway surface improvements on Griffin Road this summer. Lafarge Canada Inc. will be working in these areas from July 2, 2019 until approximately September 30, 2019.

There will be various lane closures and lane restrictions during this time to ensure pedestrian, driver and worker safety. These restrictions will be staged to minimize disruptions to citizens and traffic in the area.

Please note that this construction work is weather dependent and the schedule is subject to change.

### **How will this work impact the area?**

- Construction work on George Fox Trail will also include the installation of new signage, landscaping and site clean-up from approximately August 30 to September 21. This work is planned to take place with no lane closures and minimal traffic restrictions.
- Any applicable lane restrictions will be in place from 7am to 9pm on weekdays, and from 9am to 9pm on weekends.
