



## **George Fox Trail and Griffin Road Construction – Summer 2019**

September 18, 2019

**Road work on George Fox Trail and Griffin Road is in the final stages and is set to be completed by the end of September. Final paving on George Fox Trail is scheduled for September 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup>. Once paving is completed, new barriers and signs will be installed along the roadway. Line painting on George Fox Trail and Griffin Road is planned to be completed next week. Landscaping and site clean-up activities will continue until the end of September.**

Regular maintenance and upgrading are an important part of improving safety and extending the life of our roadways. The Town of Cochrane will be doing roadway surface, pathway, and ditch improvements to George Fox Trail, as well as roadway surface improvements on Griffin Road this summer. Lafarge Canada Inc. will be working in these areas from July 2, 2019 until approximately September 30, 2019.

There will be various lane closures and lane restrictions during this time to ensure pedestrian, driver and worker safety. These restrictions will be staged to minimize disruptions to citizens and traffic in the area.

Please note that this construction work is weather dependent and the schedule is subject to change.

### **How will this work impact the area?**

- Construction work on George Fox Trail will include paving, the installation of new signage, landscaping, and site clean-up from approximately September 19 to September 30. This work is planned to take place with lane closures and traffic restrictions.
- Driving lane restrictions may be in place from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, dependent on construction activity. Appropriate signage will present during all lane restriction activities.

The Town of Cochrane, Urban Systems and Lafarge Canada Inc. would like to thank residents for their patience and understanding during construction. We ask that pedestrians and cyclists in the area exercise caution while in the construction areas and that motorists drive with caution in the construction zones and adhere to all posted speed limits and traffic controls.
