



## George Fox Trail and Griffin Road Construction – Fall 2019

October 4, 2019

**Due to last week's inclement weather, the line painting on Griffin Road and George Fox Trail was delayed. Line painting and symbols should be completed on both roads by next week. New barriers around the Jumping Pound Creek bridge are being installed this week on George Fox Trail. Pathway paving will occur around the Jumping Pound development in the next two weeks. This will result in intermittent pathway closures and pedestrian and cyclist detours in this area.**

**Please follow all construction signage as it is in place to ensure everyone's safety. Landscaping and other clean-up activities on George Fox Trail will continue until all work is complete.**

Regular maintenance and upgrading are an important part of improving safety and extending the life of our roadways. The Town of Cochrane will be doing roadway surface, pathway, and ditch improvements to George Fox Trail, as well as roadway surface improvements on Griffin Road this summer. Lafarge Canada Inc. will be working in these areas until approximately mid-to-late October.

There will be various lane closures and lane restrictions during this time to ensure pedestrian, driver and worker safety. These restrictions will be staged to minimize disruptions to citizens and traffic in the area.

Please note that this construction work is weather dependent and the schedule is subject to change.

### How will this work impact the area?

- Construction work on George Fox Trail will include paving, the installation of new signage, landscaping, and site clean-up. This work is planned to take place with lane closures and traffic restrictions.
- Driving lane restrictions may be in place from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, dependent on construction activity. Appropriate signage will present during all lane restriction activities.
