Re: Request for continued investment in provincial highways in Cochrane

As the fastest growing community in Alberta and the 11th fastest in all of Canada, Cochrane needs roads that support the safe and efficient flow of traffic in our community.

Cochrane continues to attract new residents. And while we appreciate the new neighbours, there is a real impact on our roads – and particularly the Provincial highways in our community. With two provincial highways running through Cochrane, we need you to ensure they are able to support local traffic, as well as the daily flow of goods, services, and people.

In recent years, Cochrane has made significant investments in our roads, including the Jack Tennant Memorial Bridge and the Highway 1A Improvement Project. And just last year, the Province began a \$100M+ investment in the HWY 1A/22 interchange. These projects have made a difference in traffic flow and pedestrian safety.

However, more investment is needed to keep up with the local and regional growth. And I respectfully ask the Province to twin Highway 22 south of the interchange project.

I appreciate your attention to Cochrane's needs, including Provincial roadways, to ensure Cochrane continues to thrive.
