Emergency Preparedness: Stay Ready

Active wildfires are increasing the risk of disruption across Alberta. Upcoming weather changes could worsen these wildfires and trigger sudden evacuation orders.

#BePrepared by:

- Keeping a 72 hour emergency kit close in hand and stocked with essentials like water, nonperishable food, phone chargers, clothes, and important documents.
- Ensuring your vehicle fuel tank is full or your electric vehicle is fully charged. If you don't have a vehicle, plan with friends or contact local emergency management for support.
- Downloading the Alberta Emergency Alert and Alberta Wildfire apps.
- Checking Alberta 511 for current road conditions before traveling.
