Heading into camping season, Cochranites can once again enjoy the convenience of storing recreational vehicles on residential driveways starting May 1.

This season, keep safety in mind:

- A maximum of two recreational units may be parked/stores on a residential site at a time.
- Recreational units should not occupy or obstruct any required parking stalls.
- Parked units can not be used for sleeping, food preparation or personal hygiene while parked.
- All recreational units should be located wholly within the site and be setback a minimum of 0.6m from the rear property line where there is a rear lane.

Weed Control Starting Soon

Following the Weed Control Act to control certain plant species, Parks staff control weeds in our community using an integrated system to ensure all reasonable steps are taken to protect and enhance our natural, recreational and non-recreational environments.

As early as May 29, Parks crews may begin treating targeted areas with herbicides, steam treatment and other forms of weed control, weather permitting.

- Watch for the yellow signs that are placed at the time of application, including product safety data sheet information.
