Outdoor Skating Rinks Maintenance

Throughout the winter season, Cochrane Parks monitors the condition of the outdoor skating rinks at Tim Bannister Memorial park and Mitford pond.

Warm weather may require the rink to be closed for maintenance. Before you lace up your skates, always call the 24-hour Facility Status Line for updates: 403-851-2552.

These facilities are not supervised and are to be shared by all skaters. A reminder that Storm Water Facilities are not ponds and are not safe for skating at any time due to road salts entering them compromising the ice structure.

2023 Property Assessments on the Way

Cochrane property owners can anticipate receiving their 2023 property assessment notice in their mailbox within the next week.

Assessment notices are mailed January 20, 2023, followed by a 60-day review period, allowing property owners to review their assessment and discuss any questions or concerns before property taxes are calculated.
