Community Volunteer Income Tax Program




The Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP), offered by Cochrane FCSS, provides eligible residents assistance with filing their 2022 income taxes.

Please shovel snow in towards your properties - not out onto the road. This helps keep the roads safe and aids with clearing and stormwater flow. We (and your neighbours!) appreciate your hard work!

To help thaw ice, residents are free to use the salt/sand mix at Matt Kroll Park. Bring your own shovel and bucket. For residential use only.
