#### **Committee of the Whole**

## **Rolling Trails Area Redevelopment Plan**

Committee of the Whole was provided with an update on the draft Rolling Trails Area Redevelopment Plan. Since the Community Enhancement Evaluation presentation to Council in June of 2019, the plan has evolved significantly.

While some technical details are being finalized prior to bringing the ARP forward to Council for their consideration of adoption, Administration felt that providing an update on the progress to date was important.

## **Mitford Capital Projects**

The Mitford Lighting Capital Project RFP was closed, and bids came in over budget, that along with other constraints, Administration recommended that this project not proceed. The Mitford Irrigation Capital Project has increased by \$48,000, this is due to worldwide inflationary increases of irrigation supplies and materials. Administration recommended that consideration is given to redirecting the funds for the Mitford Lighting Capital Project to the Mitford Irrigation Capital Project.

A report requesting increased funding for the Irrigation project will be brought forward to a Regular Council meeting for Council's consideration.

#### **Fire Services Level of Service**

Council's requested that Administration provide a draft policy update to the Level of Service Policy and Procedure 1402-02 to increase the medical first response from emergency medical responder to full-scope basic life support at the primary care paramedic level. The proposed changes would increase the level of service to response no greater than full-scope BLS at the primary care paramedic level when available. When full-scope basic life support at the primary care paramedic level is not available, Fire Services will continue to respond to support citizens with the level of service available at the time of service.

The finalized document will then be submitted to the Alberta Medical First Response program to formalize the level of service change. The revised policy will be brought back to a Regular Council meeting for Council's consideration and adoption.
