## LAND USE BYLAW 11/2021 LAND USE AMENDMENT: THE WILLOWS OF RIVERSONG REDESIGNATION

Following a public hearing, Council provided second and third reading to the bylaw to redesignate one parcel of land from Public Service District (PS) to Residential Single and Two Dwelling District (R-2) in the Willows of Riversong.

In June 2021, Council authorized Administration to dispose of this property for no less than market value. This property was designated as a public utility lot for the purpose of snow storage at the time the neighbourhood was developed. Through internal review, it was determined that the parcel was not required for any municipal purpose, now or into the future.

The sale for no less than market value is now complete. This amendment aligns the land use district of the disposal parcel with the lot to which it will be consolidated with. As per the Municipal Government Act, the Town has six months to redesignate the property after the purchase. This is one of the final steps for the disposal of this parcel.
