#### **Statutory Public Hearing**

#### What is the Southbow Landing Land Use Amendment?

This is an application to change the land use on three parcels of land in the northern portion of the Southbow Landing community. The application is proposing to rezone one parcel of land from Urban Holdings (U-H) to Residential Medium Density District (R-MD), and two parcels from Urban Holdings to Residential High-Density (R-HD) District.

#### What does this mean?

The majority of the Southbow Landing community was assigned land use in 2017, except for these three parcels. This amendment will assign land use to the remaining lands in line with the Southbow Landing Neighbourhood Plan (2015), to allow for the future development of medium to high density housing in the neighbourhood.
