What is the Rolling Trails Area Redevelopment Plan?

A draft Area Redevelopment Plan was received for Council's consideration. The Plan proposes a framework to begin the process of redeveloping the Rolling Range and Towers Trail communities.

What does this mean?

Should the Plan be approved, this would be the beginning stage of allowing lands within the Rolling Trails area to redevelop into a residential community. Landowners who choose to proceed can follow the ARP and begin the redevelopment process for their lands. Should landowners not wish to redevelop, they may remain residing on their acreages for as long as they wish.

Planning staff can explain what is proposed, how it might impact you and how the Public Hearing process works.
