DID YOU KNOW YOUR LAWN
ONLY NEEDS **ONE INCH** OF
WATER **PER WEEK?**

When watering with a sprinkler, lay a frisbee upside down within range of your sprinkler. When it fills up turn your sprinkler off. That's about 25mm (1") of water - all an established lawn needs in a week.
