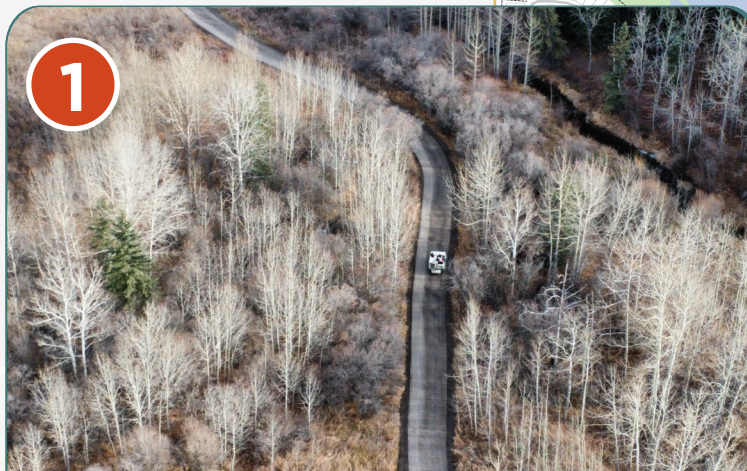
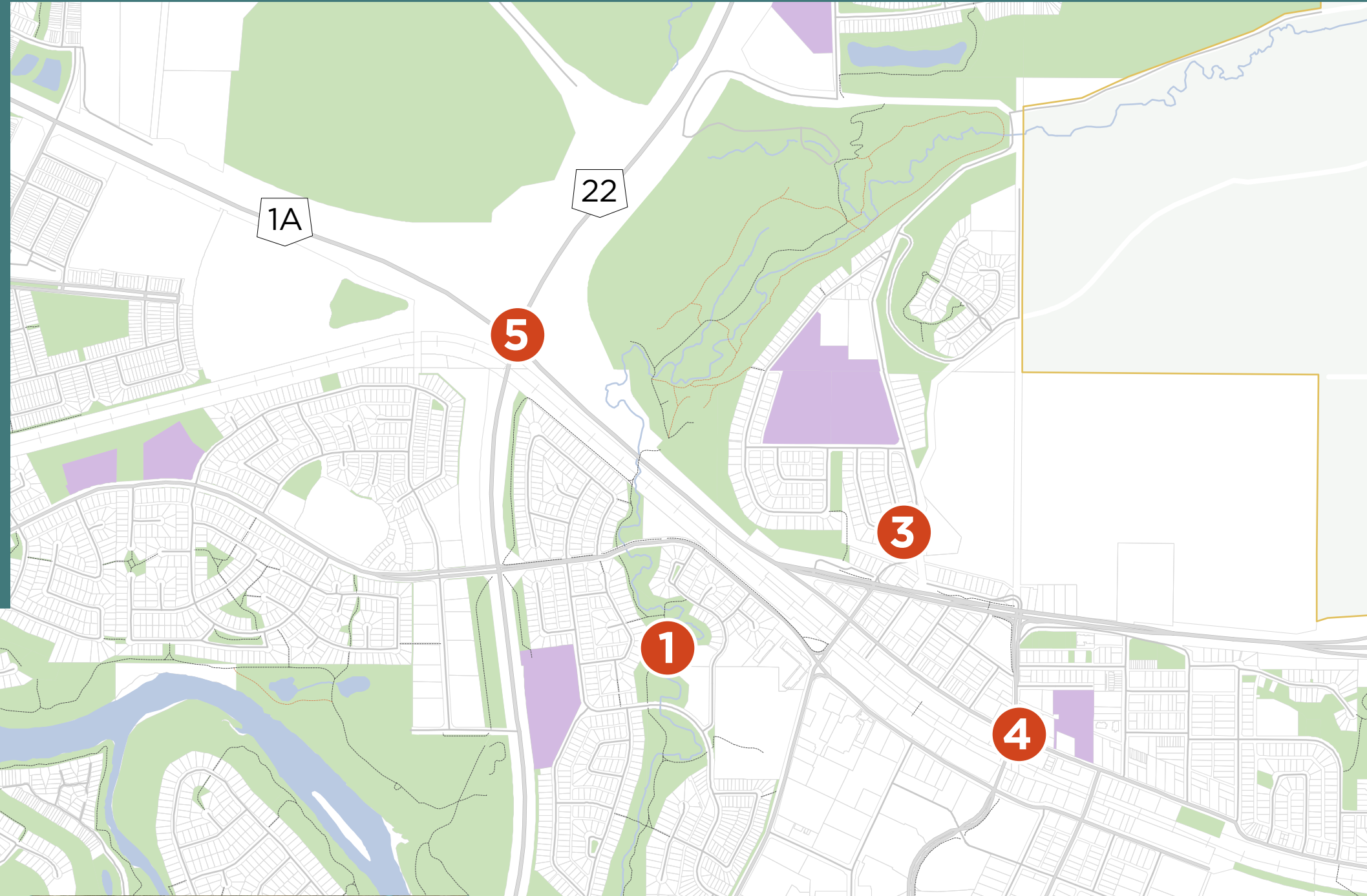


# 2024: COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION

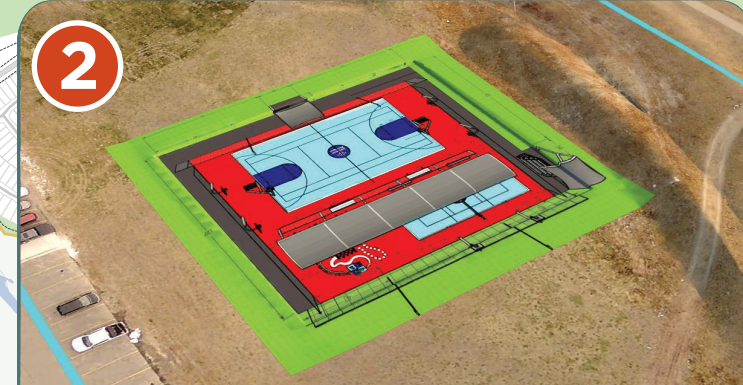

Bringing significant improvements to our community, particularly through upgraded roadways and strengthened connections throughout Cochrane. These efforts have made our town more vibrant, accessible and safer, while also enhancing travel and recreational opportunities for all residents.

## Historic Ranche & Glenbow Pathway Improvement

This project includes paving nearly 3 km of pathways in Glenbow and the Historic Cochrane Ranche, along with the replacement of four pedestrian bridges in Glenbow. Nearing completion, this initiative is set to enhance pathway connections and provide more inclusive access to our trail system. New signage is planned for installation throughout the pathway in 2025.



## Jumpstart Play Courts

Project Jumpstart is donating an accessible multi-sport court behind SLS Centre. Cochrane completed the foundation work this year. Final installation and landscaping will take place next year with the public opening planned for Spring/Summer 2025.



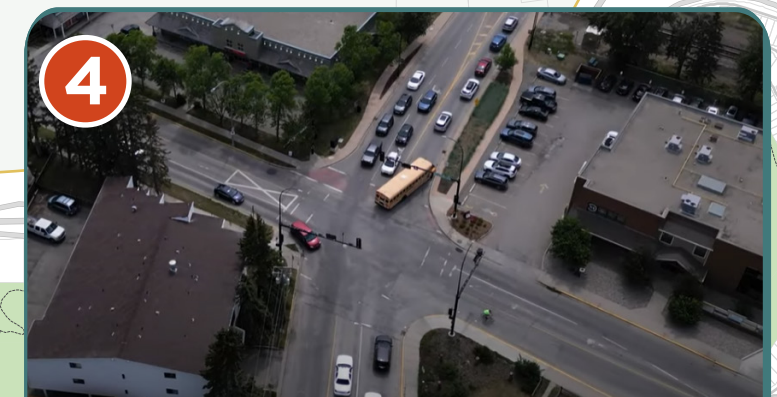
## Fourth Avenue Wall

The installation of the decorative wall facing and lighting was completed, transforming the highway into a work of art day or night. The green space in front is taking shape and will continue to develop in time.



## Hwy 1A/22 Interchange

Work continues on the Province's interchange project with major transformations to the roadway and landscape. The project is estimated to be completed in late 2025.



## Centre Avenue Phase 3

The Centre Avenue widening project, extending from Powell Street to 1st Street, was completed this year, improving access to Historic Downtown and enhancing one of Cochrane's main corridors. The final layer of pavement will be installed in 2025, once settling is complete, to finish the roadway.
