Council adopts 2025 budget

On December 9, 2024, Council approved the 2025 budget, outlining Cochrane's goals and key projects for the coming year. The budget includes \$96 million for municipal operations and \$85.5 million for capital projects in 2025, with a focus on sustainable growth and maintaining high-quality services for residents. The full budget document will be available for public review in early 2025.

River Heights Water Storage Expansion Bylaw 27/2024

Cochrane Council proposes to pass a borrowing bylaw to finance construction of the River Heights Water Storage Expansion project in the amount of \$6,938,000. The borrowing is expected to be repaid over a 30-year time frame, from off-site levies and municipal taxes.

The public may inspect the proposed bylaw at Legislative Services, Cochrane RancheHouse, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Electors may submit a separate petition with respect to the advertised bylaw calling for a vote of the electors to determine whether the proposed bylaw should be passed. The petition must meet the formal requirements of Sections 221-226 of the Municipal Government Act and be filed with the Director, Legislative Services within 15 days of the last date the proposed bylaw is advertised: December 19, 2024. Any petition is public information. This bylaw will be considered by Cochrane Council at the Monday, January 13, 2025 Regular Council Meeting.
