This proposal aims to:



What is being proposed?

Conseil Scolaire FrancoSud is proposing to locate a new secondary school within the subject parcel which could accommodate up to 300 students (grades 7-12).

What does this mean?

The main objective for providing the secondary school is to alleviate the over-crowding situation at the adjacent École Notre-Dame des Vallées, which was originally built for grades K-8. The subject parcel is Town-owned land. FrancoSud is asking Council for a letter of support that would help them apply for Provincial funding to plan and build the school. Council requested to first hold a Public Hearing prior to any and decisions being made.
