All businesses operating in Cochrane, including home-based and non-resident, need a valid Town of Cochrane business licence.

In 2026, annual licences won't auto-renew. Instead, business owners will simply complete the quick online renewal application each year. Renewal fees are due January 31. Licence certificates will now be emailed for your convenience.
