Horse Creek Sports Park Former School Site Municipal Reserve Designation Removal

Council directed Administration to notify the Land Titles Registrar that the provisions of Division 9 of the *Municipal Government Act* have been complied with and request the Registrar to remove the designation of Municipal Reserve from the former school site on the Horse Creek Sports Park.

This designation removal is required as a housekeeping item to allow for the former school site to be consolidated back into the parcel, facilitating the future Sports Park development. No additional work is required for the preferred school site, which has already been subdivided and transferred to Rocky View School Division.
