About the Board

The Environmental Appeals Board is an independent quasi-judicial body that hears appeals of certain decisions made by Alberta Environment and Protected Areas.

Interventions

Any person, other than the parties, who wishes to make a representation before the Board on these appeals must submit a request in writing by fax or by e-mail to the Board at the fax number or e-mail address set out below. The request must be received by the Board on or before **February 5, 2026**. It is your responsibility to ensure that your request is received by the Board by **February 5, 2026**. Such a request shall (a) contain the name, address, e-mail, and telephone and fax numbers of the person submitting the request, (b) indicate whether the person submitting the request intends to be represented by a lawyer or agent and, if so, the name of the lawyer or agent, (c) contain a summary of the nature of the person's interest in these appeals, and (d) be signed by the person submitting the request. Applications will only be considered if the information will assist the Board in making its decision and will not duplicate the information provided by the parties. After **February 5, 2026**, the Board will, in its discretion, determine if other persons may make representations, and the manner in which they can be made.

Public Viewing

Hearings held via videoconference are generally not open to the public. If you wish to view the hearing you may contact the Board to request a link. Requests to view the hearing are at the discretion of the Board and are not automatically granted. The Board will provide a copy of the hearing audio recording upon request.

The information requested is necessary to allow the Environmental Appeals Board to perform its function.
