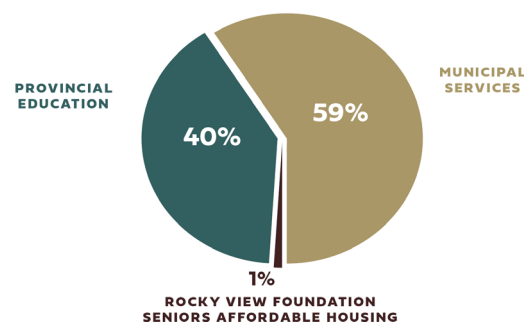
Property tax payments due June 30

Payments can be made in person at the RancheHouse or the Station, through your bank, by mail, online using your tax roll number or can be dropped off after hours at the RancheHouse or the FCSS building.

Where do your property taxes go?

Your property taxes are split between municipal and provincial services.

- 59% supports municipal services include roads, parks and pathways, community safety and more
- 40% supports Provincial education
- 1% supports the Rocky View Foundation's seniors' housing



In 2026, the provincial education requisition was significantly increased (19.8%), with the municipal tax rate bylaw only increasing by approximately 2.5% on the median household.

Payments made on or after July 1 will receive late payment penalties so ensure to pay your bills by June 30.
