Cochrane is welcoming more than 1,100 athletes from 26 countries for IRONMAN 70.3 Calgary at Cochrane on July 25 and 26.

Race weekend will bring plenty of energy and excitement to the community, with the greatest traffic impacts expected on Sunday, July 26.

Temporary road closures are planned on Glenbow Drive and Glenpatrick Drive from approximately 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Delays are also expected near Highway 22, the Sunset entrance and RancheHouse Road.

Removing black henbane

Black Henbane is a noxious weed under the Alberta Weed Control Act. A single plant can produce up to 500,000 seeds, making early control important.

All parts of the plant are poisonous if ingested and contact with skin can cause irritation.

If you're removing Black Henbane:

- Wear gloves, long sleeves and pants
- Pull or dig the plant out at the root
- Bag plant material and place it in the garbage (black bin). Do not compost or use the green bin.
