Electronic Communications Bylaw

Administration presented a report for a proposed bylaw to send property assessment and tax notices electronically, aiming to reduce the annual \$50,000 cost for printing and postage. With a 50% opt-in rate, the Town could save \$25,000 per year. The initiative also offers residents more flexibility and improved customer service through electronic delivery.
