Delegation: Cochrane Society for Housing Options

In September 2023 the Cochrane Society for Housing Options (CSHO) presented Council with an Affordable Housing Brief that outlined the need for additional affordable housing in Cochrane. Following the presentation, the CSHO committed to identifying the ideal characteristics that a parcel of land would contain so that it is ready to be transformed into new affordable housing.

The CSHO presented their criteria for land suitable for affordable housing construction to assist Council in determining a parcel of land that could be provided to CSHO to develop into new affordable housing.

Public Engagement Policy 1106-03

Cochrane's public engagement policy was originally adopted in June 2006, with revision approvals in 2014 and 2018. Administration has drafted policy updates for Council's consideration that reflect a jurisdictional and legislative scan, as well as feedback collected through the Let's Talk

Cochrane public engagement conducted in late 2023.

Cochrane Age Friendly Initiative - Update

Administration provided Council with an update on the status of the Cochrane Age Friendly Initiative, including the public engagement results as summarized in the "What We Heard" report.

The insights gathered from the public engagement will help to inform the development of an action plan. The Cochrane Age-Friendly Steering Committee will be developing an action plan for Council's feedback and consideration.
